

LAA July Meeting

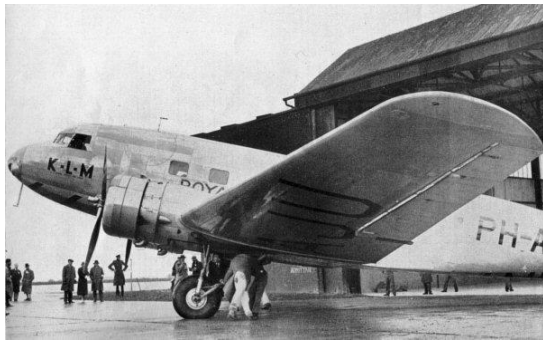
